- 1 The following measurements only will be over 14hh & not exceeding 15hh, Hacks over 15hh. accepted: Ponies 14hh & under, Galloways
- 2 Stewards reserve the right to have horses measured on both days.
- 3 Horse may compete only once in each event.
- 4 In all cases of boy/girl rider, proof of age must be produced, signed by parent or teacher, if required by the Society. Each child to compete in own age group.
- 5 Galloways cannot compete in Hack classes.
- 6 All stock to be true in type, otherwise no prize. The committee reserves the right to make any changes in the timetable as rendered necessary. Adequate notice of such alteration will be given over the public address system.
- 7 Novice – a horse that has not won a champion ribbon under saddle at an agricultural show. Intermediate – a horse that has not won a first prize at a Royal Show. Exhibitors competing in Maiden classes must not have won a first prize prior to the day of the show.
- 8 Any rider deemed by the stewards to be under the influence of drugs or alcohol shall be barred from riding and not be eligible for Riders Registration compensation.
- 9 All campdraft and sporting events run under ABCRA Rules.
- 10 All horses competing at the Show compete on the understanding that drug testing may be carried out at this Show. It is your responsibility to know the Rules and Regulations regarding this drug testing program and this Show will not in any way accept responsibility for your lack of knowledge and/or understanding of this subject. AJC Rulings apply.
- 11 District Classes. Competitors and horses resident within Uralla Shire.
- 12 Registered Classes. Registration papers to be shown to steward or judges upon request.
- 13 All competitors aged 17 years and under must compete in headwear applicable to the event in which they are competing.
- 14 All colts and stallions must have a handler who is over 18 years of age.
- 15 Prize money for the Champion Hack Galloway and Pony and show hunter classes will be presented after the Hack Show has been judged.
- 16 Judging Awards. The judge has sole jurisdiction to issue or withhold prizes, and the judge's decision is final.
- 17 Three calls for each event. Competitors who are late may be refused entry to the Ring. Competitors whose classes clash must provide another rider.
- 18 No mobile phones or communication equipment permitted in the horse rings by competitors.
- 19 A Parent or Parents of Child shall NOT enter the Show Ring whilst the competitor is competing in any event unless so authorised by the Chief Ring Stewards and two Committee Members, and the Sub Committee shall take whatever action it deems appropriate.

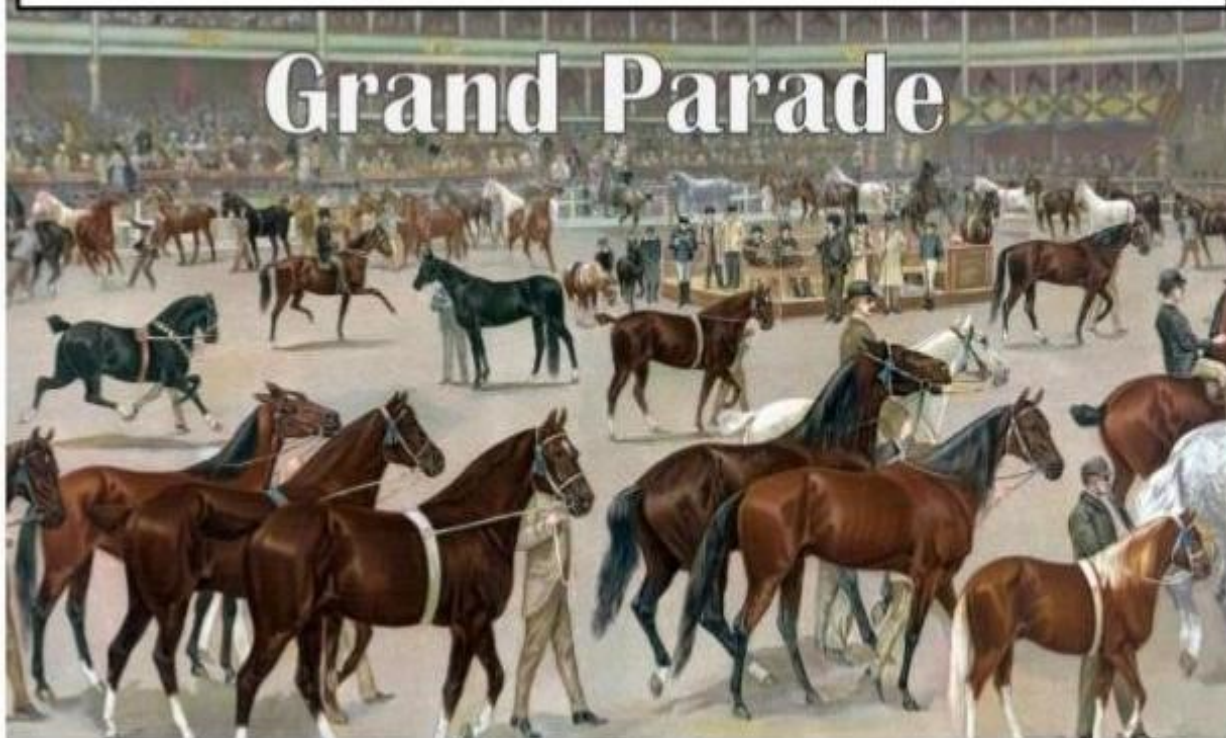

Each adult competitor must before competing, complete and sign a form indemnifying the Uralla District Show Society and waiving competitor's property or damage caused by the competitor and his/her animal(s) at the Show. A similar form must also be completed and signed by a parent or guardian for each competitor who is under 18 years of age. Also, on each Waiver, each horse with which the competitor is involved in competition at the show must be listed together with the Property Identification Code (PIC) of the property from which the horse came to the show.

A Wristband will be issued to each competitor after completion of waiver form. NO ARMBAND – NO ENTRY.

High Point Awards for:

Youth, Amateur, Beginner/Improver, Junior Horse, Senior Horse, Ranch Horse (All Aged), Ranch Horse (Any Handed), Ranch Horse (Snaffle Bit).

Notes:

- (i) Events run under HSAA and AQHA rules.
 - (ii) Halter classes for 3 years and under may be split if sufficient entries.
 - (iii) At the discretion of the organisers and the judge some classes may be run together.
 - (iv) Beginner/Improver classes - gear used is optional (English, Western or Australian), but must be safe. No illegal gear permitted.
 - (v) As per HSAA rules “No horse may cross-enter a Western Pleasure and Ranch Riding class at the same shown”.
 - (vi) Ranch Classes: Classes are in line with AQHA performance rules. All horses must be 3 years or over.
- All Aged: Correct tack and attire applies as per rules.
 Any Handed: A horse & rider combination, who have never won an equivalent amateur/select amateur, open or all aged class in an AQHA affiliated/approved show.
 Snaffle Bit: Horse to be ridden 2 handed in a snaffle bit regardless of age. Fender, stock saddle or half-breed saddles only. No western saddles. Cannot enter All Aged.
